CRA Donates \$55,000 Back to the Community and Eighteen Low Income Homeowners Receive New Roofs!

The Colorado Roofing Association (CRA) and Rebuilding Together Metro Denver teamed up once again for another successful National Rebuilding Day in the Denver metro area!

The CRA is very proud of all its participating members for helping this Colorado non-profit organization. Rebuilding Together Metro Denver works in partnership with the community to rehabilitate the houses of low-income homeowners, particularly the elderly and disabled, so that they may continue to live in warmth, safety and independence. These two Colorado organizations have been teaming up to keep homeowners DRY since April of 2001.

Warm, Safe, and specifically DRY was the GOAL for members of the CRA throughout the month of April. With the help of thirty-four roofing contractors, the CRA looked at the roofs on thirty-three homes in the

Denver Metro area. The roofs ranged from no work to complete tear offs with deck replacement. When it was all said and done the CRA completed eighteen re-roofs, six repairs, and nine on site roof inspections, for a total of almost \$55,000 in donated material and labor.

April 30th, the day slated as National Rebuilding Day, had 30 Rebuilding Together teams repairing low-income homes in the Denver Metro area. In the spirit of volunteerism, the CRA once again choose to repair a home of it's own. On April 30th, CRA member volunteers met at the Bridgeway House and went to work. The Bridgeway House is a home for unwed mothers with babies who have nowhere else to go. With a combined donation from the CRA and Dawn Rehbein of Statewide Wholesale, the CRA replaced the flooring in two kitchens and put in two new counter tops. Outside, a new walkway was built; the yard cleaned up, painting, and some landscaping was all completed. Rebuilding Together also donated a brand new energy efficient refrigerator to the home. A special thanks to Matt Smith with Rebuilding Together and Tom Cook with Statewide Wholesale for going beyond the call of duty to make everything happen at the Bridgeway House. Lastly, thanks to those individuals who volunteered their Saturday to repair the Bridgeway House; Joanie Homie, Amy Hawkins, Dawn Rehbein, Susan Crossman, Rob McReynolds, Ted Crossman, Dave Suer, Jeff Butler, Andy Grinolds, Rick Merica, Tom Cook and Larry Reinhard.
